Remy Bastings

Born on the 2nd of september 1975 in Maastricht

Don't remember when I started riding. Horses were always in my life through both my grandfathers. That's where I started.

1985 I got my own pony after riding my grandfathers' horses.

1989 I worked also with Haflingers and I drove four-in-hand with them

1992 I went to "Deurne" which is the Dutch school to become a professional rider and trainer.

There I did my working student periods at a jumping stable, a riding school and at the dressage stable of Chris and Jeannette Haazen.

1995 My last and most period with Reitmeister Johann Hinnemann in Germany.

It was the pre-Olympic year and I followed the training of horses like Ferro, Rusty, Rubinstein, Beauvalais and many others.

Went to several major CDI's as the "eyes on the ground" for Leonie Bramall (CAN)

1996, March graduated from "Deurne" with high marks for jumping and dressage and the highest mark ever for riding young horses

April, moved to Canada with the horses of Canadian team members Leonie Bramall and Gina Smith for the selection trials for the Olympic games

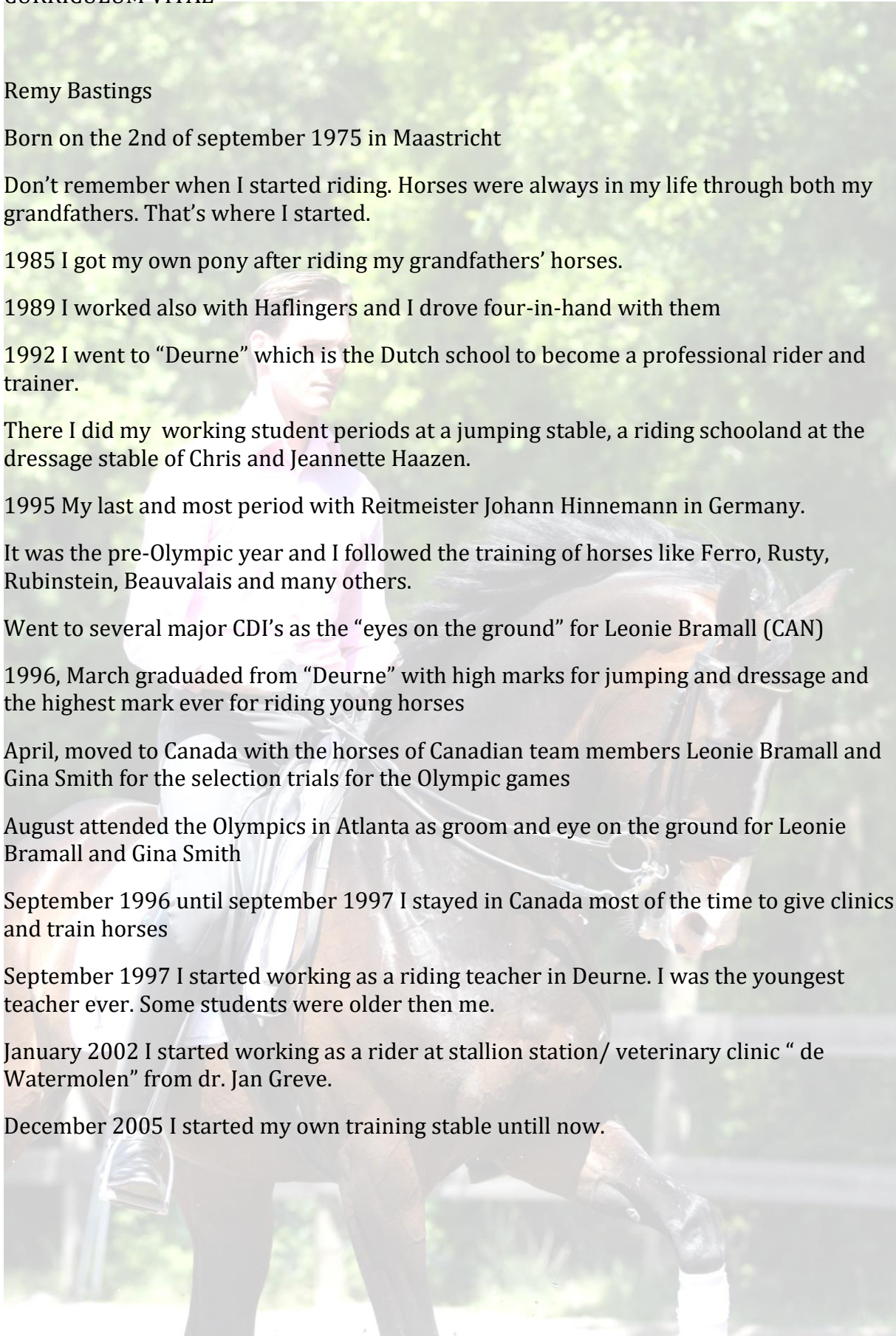
August attended the Olympics in Atlanta as groom and eye on the ground for Leonie Bramall and Gina Smith

September 1996 until september 1997 I stayed in Canada most of the time to give clinics and train horses

September 1997 I started working as a riding teacher in Deurne. I was the youngest teacher ever. Some students were older than me.

January 2002 I started working as a rider at stallion station/ veterinary clinic "de Watermolen" from dr. Jan Greve.

December 2005 I started my own training stable until now.



Over the years I have trained :

Over 20 horses until medium level

over 15 horses until prix saint George/ intermediair 1 level

8 until grand prix level.

In 2003 regional champion with Cordace and vice Champion with Master Mind

In 2004 regional champion with Master Mind ,4th at the Dutch championships

In 2005 regional champion with Riverdance,

In 2003 and 2004 I won the stallion competition with Scandic. (now under Patrik Kittel very succesful) Vice champion with him in the PAVO cup.

In 2004 10th place with Scandic on the world championships for young horses in Verden

In 2005 Dutch Champion with Riverdance in the medium/advanced level

In 2009 10th place in the PAVOcup with Zecchino

In 2010 Riverdance and I won the pr st George in the Sunshine Tour in Vejer de la Frontera, Spain and were placed every ride we had during the three weeks of the competition

With Zecchino I won 4 out of 6 classes for 6 year old horses with scores up to 88%

In 2011 8th place in the Dutch championships grand prix with Riverdance

In 2012 6th at the CDN Aachen in Grand Prix

Many more wins and placings in many competitions
